

Instruction Manual

1. Fan Operation

- Press the Power Button once to start the fan running at speed level 1, with the digital display showing "20";
- Press again for speed level 2, with the digital display showing "40";
- Press again for speed level 3, with the digital display showing "60";
- Press again for speed level 4, with the digital display showing "80";
- Press again for speed level 5, with the digital display showing "100";
- Press once more and the fan unit powers off, and the LED indicator dims off;
- After setting the speed level, the digital display will revert to showing the current battery level;
- Long press the Power Button for 2 seconds at any speed level to power off the fan;
- Press the Ice Button once to activate ice cooling pad function, Ice Button indicator will light up. Press again to deactivate function.

2. Power Charging Operation

While charging the fan with the provided charging cable, the digital display flashes to indicate the battery level. When fully charged, it displays "100%".

Charging time: Approximately 3 hours and 30 minutes to fully charge with DC 5V, 2A input.

4. Important Note

- This fan unit needs to be USB powered with DC 5V voltage supply, please do not use too high or too low voltage charger for charging.

- When the fan is powered on and is in operating mode, please do not insert your fingers / foreign objects into the fan's protective nettings / grilles. The fan will be damaged and may cause injury to you.
- Do not stop the operating fan blades with foreign objects at all times, otherwise the control circuit or fan motor will be burned out due to excessive current. The fan will be damaged and may cause injury to you.
- When the fan unit has not been used for more than 2 months, please charge the fan to 75% power capacity for storage and battery protection.
- Children should only operate the fan unit under the guidance of adults responsible for their safety. Close supervision is constantly required.
